

BARBARA WHEELER

The accomplishments of Barbara Wheeler, PhD, MT-BC over her multipledecade career in the profession of music therapy are many and multi-faceted. She has produced hundreds of publications, peer-reviewed journal articles, and presentations that have impacted not only the United States music therapy community, but also international practitioners and students. More recently, she curated and edited *Music Therapy Handbook* for Guilford Publications. Her contributions are generously given as she has traveled throughout the world at the request of universities, music therapy associations, and music therapists to educate the public about the power of music therapy to repair and heal, based on her extensive knowledge of best practices and approaches. Dr. Wheeler's knowledge of music therapy and related research has also made her a sought-after reviewer and editorial board member for many major journal publications. Dr. Wheeler's lifelong investment in promoting music therapy, its educational

standards, standards of professional practice, and credentials have been significant. She served the American Music Therapy Association as President, Vice President, Arthur Flagler Fultz Award Chair, and many other national and regional positions of professional service.

ROBERT GROENE

Robert "Bob" Groene, PhD, MT-BC, has given himself tirelessly to the profession of music therapy. After working primarily as a clinician in the early part of his career, he launched a notable career in academia, directing the program at the University of Missouri-Kansas City and educating hundreds of future music therapists. Bob has served the Kansas City Metro Music Therapists, both the national and Midwestern Regional organizations of the American Music Therapy Association, and the former National Association for Music Therapy in a variety of capacities. Some of his more recognizable contributions include service to AMTA on the Standards of Clinical Practice Committee, the Professional Competencies Review Task Force, the Assembly of Delegates, Conference Local Arrangement Chair, and President of the Midwestern Region. He has also served as an editorial board member for *The Arts in Psychotherapy, Music Therapy Perspectives, The Journal of Music Therapy*, and the *Missouri Journal of Research in Music*

Education. Dr. Groene has been recognized for his contributions, receiving the Muriel McBrien Kauffman Excellence in Teaching Award in both 2002 and 2004, the AMTA Midwestern Region Research Award, the AMTA Service Award, and a Presidential Commendation from the AMTA Midwestern Region. Bob is a music therapist, mentor, and educator who is unfailingly supportive of his students and shows immense compassion for the people he has served as a music therapist.

KEYNOTE ADDRESS TED BOWMAN

Friday, November 22, 9:30 am–10:30 am, Nicollet Grand Ballroom DISRUPTIVE CHANGES, THRESHOLDS, AND CROSSROADS: CHALLENGES FOR CARING WORK

Caring work frequently includes attention to changes, often major changes. Music therapists are there at the cusp of life with birthing persons, at the cusp of death in hospice settings, and all the stages and ages between. They are also present when organizational, staff, and procedural changes alter the work they do. Well-being with ambiguity and flexibility is essential for each music therapist, but is often easier said than done. When disruptions occur, when dreams are shattered, C when detours are required, our stories are altered. This work has been and is about facing such changes with a range of resources toward resiliency, adjustments and transformation. Music, for many, probably most, is a key resource. In the plenary session, Ted Bowman, MDiv, will draw on music as a metaphor for improvisation, for balancing dissonance and harmony, for healing, and for that which inspires people to keep going. Woven into the session will be music, words, and images. Perspective and tools for working in ever-changing contexts will be addressed and discussed. Disruptive changes, even positive ones, can include loss and grief. Hence, resiliency and honest strategies for

coping will be included.



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CONTINUING EDUCATION

CONFERENCE ATTENDANCE 5 CMTE CREDITS

Registrants may earn 5 Continuing Music Therapy Education (CMTE) credits for attending this conference; a maximum of 50 CMTE credits for AMTA National and Regional conferences attendance per 5-year cycle may be acquired. Concurrent sessions and CMTE opportunities may be claimed in addition to these conference attendance credits.

CMTE APPROVED OPPORTUNITIES

Add-on Courses with CMTE opportunities are offered in conjunction with the conference. Registrants may earn up to 100 CMTE credits for attending CMTE pre-approved opportunities. Upon completion of the CMTE evaluation form at the end of each CMTE opportunity, registrants will receive a certificate indicating completion of each learning experience via email within two weeks after the conclusion of the conference.

CONCURRENT SESSIONS
