



This is the COVID-19 Task Force survey conducted of faculty and clinical supervisors in cooperation with the Faculty Forum and relevant AMTA committees.




246 responded91 (37%) faculty156 (63% clinical supervisors and/or internship directors)




Faculty members responded represented all seven regions with Great Lakes region with the most responders (20)


64 responded to this question.




Academic sites range in the number of pre-internship sites they supported before the pandemic with 65% of responders (n=5() noting a range of 6 to 20 sites.



65% of faculty reported difficulty in finding/securing pre-intership sites




84% reporting temporary loss of pre-internship sites due to COVID-19 restrictions




Permanently lost pre-internship sites ranged in type if site but community-based sites, mental health sites, private practice, and nursing home sites tended to be noted as lost/closed.



Q11: If you have temporarily lost pre-internship sites, when do you anticipate that the majority of sites will return ?








If you look at National Registry sites only, there are 172 sites per Jane Creagan. 172 is our denominator, therefore.

This chart shows 31 students (or 18% of NR sites) not cancelled, paused, or accepted but delayed while a minimum of 99 students were cancelled, paused or delayed after acceptance. So roughly 82% students have been affected based on this sample of 41 faculty.




Interpretation of aspects of this question by faculty is a consideration but impact of internship delays appears to be most affecting graduation dates, students' income earning potential, and their housing arrangements.

Int'l student visa status and scholarships had some impact but less so than the other factors. That could, perhaps, be reflecting lower numbers of students on visas or scholarship

Mixed telehealth and face-to-face led as far as the number of student interns in this mode. However, full time telehealth and some face-to-face full time still exist in lesser presence.




Faculty and Clinical Supervisors make use of many sources to help students meet preinternship or internship hours including peer networking, AMTA resrouces, and related resrouces are all used.








57% noted COVID-19 restrictions currently prevent clinical supv/internship directors from hosting in-person pre-internship students.




















